Terms of Sale

Bidding

1. By placing a bid you accept the terms of sale.
2. Every lot shall be bid upon as numbered, any lot may be withdrawn at any time.
3. Lots are sold at one bid increment over the second highest bid.
4. All lots are sold for the hammer price plus a 15% commission.
5. Bidding starts at one bid increment over the second highest mail bid.

Payment

1. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice and winning lots will be shipped upon receipt of payment.
2. Shipping will be by USPS or UPS with insurance at cost + \$3.25 handling per package.
3. Successful bidders agree to pay for their purchases. No credit is extended without prior agreement and accounts in default will be charged 2% per month interest after 30 days.
4. Virginia residents and in-person bidders must pay 5.3% state sales tax.
5. Tax-exempt customers must provide a tax exempt number and certificate prior to the auction or pay taxes due.

Returns

1. Any lot described in error can be returned for a full refund within 15 days of receipt.
2. For any lot being sent out for expertization, we will accept returns as long as we're notified in writing within 15 days of receipt. If notified, we will refund the cost up to \$50 for any item expertized as 'not genuine'.

1. Live bidding will be online only at www.evstamps.com under auctions.
2. Bids may be placed on Stamp Auction Network up until 12PM EST the day of the auction. No live bidding will take place on Stamp Auction Network. After bidding on SAN bids will be manually entered into www.evstamps.com. For real time bidding and updates please log in and use www.evstamps.com instead of stampauctionnetwork.com.
3. Absentee bids will be taken by email, text, phone, mail, or in person - please get them to us as soon as possible to make sure there is time to enter them into the auction.

- 56** #1 Penny Black lightly canceled with creases and staining, still an attractive little cover
- 57** #3 on cover with red Paid, Farrington Place cancels & Providence, RI CDS with manuscript notice The American postage has been paid by T.W.J., scarce use of stamp as forwarder, fantastic cover

- 61** 1859 India Used in Burma Cover, Moulmein to Ragoon with 1a QV tied by fair B-127 of Moulmein, backed by illegible red mark (probably Moulmein Proud type D2) and very fine boxed red Rangoon Shipletter Type SL2 with inside script reading "1859 / Gardner Brooke & Co. / Moulmein 28th December / Ansr 9th January 1860"
- 62** 1860s India Used in Burma Cover, Ragoon(?) to Moulmein with 1a QV tied by indistinct mark probably Moulmein Proud type KD9 (used 1865-69) and endorsed per Bushire
- 63** 1870s India Used in Burma - 2 Covers with B-179 Thayetmyo Octagonal cancel, described by Davis as "very rare" incl Apr 11, 1872 partial CDS cover, other dated May 6, 1872 on reverse. These Proud Type D5 marks are both late dating & are missing the A so read "THYETMYO" and may be an unrecorded type

SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR COVERS



The Spanish-American War was a very brief war by today's standards in which 3,000 Americans lost their lives. While the war was fought mainly over the independence of Cuba, the US ended with temporary control of Cuba, the Philippines, Puerto Rico, and Hawaii. This ushered in a fascinating era of US stamp and cover collecting.

On February 15, 1898 the USS Maine, while sitting in Havana Harbor, exploded. Thanks to the "Yellow Journalism" of the time, this news was met with calls for war by the US public.

Against his better judgement, President McKinley declared war on Spain on April 21st. Two days later, on April 23rd the first shot was fired by the USS Nashville.

200,000 Men volunteered and were sent to Jacksonville, FL and Camp Chickamauga, GA among other destinations. They fought over the next ten weeks, but the three most important battles during the war took place in May & July. On May 1st, George Dewey and 9 American ships destroyed 10 Spanish ships in the battle of Manila. Just 6 American casualties matched 600 on the Spanish side. On July 3rd US ships and infantry decimated Spain's fleet in the battle of Santiago Harbor. And from July 1st through 15th, Teddy Roosevelt and his Rough Riders took the hills on their way to Santiago forcing surrender of Spanish forces.

The US then moved to Puerto Rico and on August 12th, 1898 Spain and the United States officially ended hostilities.

Because the fighting only lasted ten weeks, and the signing Of the Treaty of Paris happened just a few months later in December, this is a fascinating period of US Postal History. There were over 500 designs of Patriotic Covers issued between 1898 and 1900, and some were used for many years afterwards. While some designs were common, many of the stamp usages were not.

Pay close attention to not only the dates listed above, but the locations of each mailing. Covers sent during the hostilities are rare, but we are also offering covers sent from Cuba, the Philippines, Hawaii, as well as military bases and ports of departure in the United States.

The following collection has not been on the market for over twenty years. It is truly amazing, with many covers that are simply stunning, and many that are simply rare. There is something here for everyone, whether you collect US, worldwide, postal history, wartime, possessions, and more. We are proud to present it in its entirety.
